How climate change affects rural Spain.

1. Brief introduction to the lesson topic.

Climate change is a global problem. In our lesson we want people to realize how this problem is affecting them, as individuals, and all of us as a system. In order to do that, we are going to show our personal experiences related with climate change, starting with a specific problem (how it affects our villages), and going on it trying to make people think about the scale of climate change.

2. Target group.

We focus our lesson and the workshop to adults as we are going to perform at Pangaea. However, the lesson and the activities can be easily modified in order to adapt it to teenagers and kids. As future teachers, we want to promote critical thinking, and this is a topic with a huge value to bring it to the class.

3. Main objectives.

- A) Promote the **individual actions** to reduce and mitigate the effects climate change.
- B) Aware people about the interdependence of climate change consequences among countries. Globalization.
- C) Promote the awareness about the crucial importance of agriculture in human lives.
- D) Inform about the importance of **defending rural lifestyle**.

4. Lesson content

In order to reach our lesson and workshop objectives, the knowledge that we are going to show is the following:

1. *Rural Spain lifestyle*. We are going to talk about our own experiences in Spain, extending the information that we show in our video to reach a better understanding of the meaning of the olive sector and the wine sector in our villages.

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2. *Climate change consequences in rural contexts*. Climate change is a problem that affects farmers directly. Sometimes we think about climate change as a problem far from us, a situation that concern us in general and not as individuals, or we just think that it is more a future problem than an actual problem. Therefore, we are going to show an actual situation where climate change is causing a huge impact. Spain is one of the most affected countries by climate change.

3. The importance of agriculture in the society. Although the 54% of the world population live in urban areas, thousand millions of people live in rural contexts, where agriculture is the principal source of livelihood. Agriculture is one of the essential activities in society; therefore what happens on the agriculture sphere has consequences in our lives, directly and indirectly.
